OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Amendment in Central Civil Services (Conduct) Rules, 1964 regarding acceptance of gifts by Government servants.

The undersigned is directed to say that the following rules of Central Civil Services (Conduct) Rules, 1964 prescribing ceiling for receiving gifts by Government servants, have been amended vide G.S.R. No. 531 (E) dated 29.07.2019 (copy enclosed) so as to bring the uniformity in provisions of CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964, AIS (Conduct) Rules, 1968 and Foreign Contribution (Acceptance or Retention of Gifts or Presentations) Rules, 2012:

In all other cases, the acceptance and retention of such gift shall be regulated by the instructions issued by the Government in this regard from time to time.</p>	<p>Sub-rule (4) of Rule 13</p> <p>Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-rule (2) and (3), a Government servant, being a member of the Indian delegation or otherwise, may receive and retain gifts from foreign dignitaries in accordance with the provisions of The Foreign Contribution (Acceptance or Retention of Gifts or Presentation) Rules, 2012, as amended from time to time.</p>



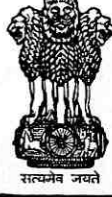

सा.का.नि. 531(अ).—राष्ट्रपति, संविधान के अनुच्छेद 309 के परंतुक और अनुच्छेद 148 के खंड (5) द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए तथा भारत के नियंत्रक-महालेखापरीक्षक से परामर्श करने के पश्चात भारतीय लेखा परीक्षा और लेखा विभाग में कार्यरत व्यक्तियों के संबंध में केन्द्रीय सिविल सेवाएँ (आचरण) नियमावली, 1964 में और संशोधन करने के लिए निम्नलिखित नियम बनाते हैं, अर्थात्:—

1. **संक्षिप्त नाम और प्रारंभ:-** (1) इन नियमों का संक्षिप्त नाम केन्द्रीय सिविल सेवाएँ (आचरण) संशोधन नियमावली, 2019 है।

(2) ये राजपत्र में इनके प्रकाशन की तारीख को प्रवृत्त होंगे।

2. केन्द्रीय सिविल सेवाएँ (आचरण) नियमावली, 1964 के नियम 13 में,-

(क) उपनियम (3) में खण्ड (i) और (ii) के स्थान पर निम्नलिखित खण्ड रखे जाएंगे, अर्थात्:—

“(i) किसी भी समूह ‘क’ या समूह ‘ख’ पद को धारण करने वाले सरकारी सेवक के मामले में पांच हजार रुपए; और

(ii) किसी भी समूह ‘ग’ पद को धारण करने वाले सरकारी सेवक के मामले में दो हजार रुपए।”;

(ख) उप-नियम (4) के स्थान पर निम्नलिखित उप-नियम रखा जाएगा, अर्थात्:—

“उपनियम (2) और (3) में किसी बात के होते हुए भी भारतीय प्रतिनिधिमण्डल का सदस्य या अन्यथा होते हुए एक सरकारी सेवक, समय-समय पर यथा-संशोधित विदेशी अभिदाय (दान या भेंट की स्वीकृति या प्रतिधारण) नियम, 2012 के उपबंधों के अनुसार विदेशी उच्च पदाधिकारियों से दान प्राप्त और प्रतिधारित कर सकता है।”।

G.S.R. 531(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 and clause (5) of article 148 of the Constitution and after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India in relation to persons serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Central Civil Services (Conduct) Rules, 1964, namely:—

1. **Short title and commencement:**— (1) These rules may be called the Central Civil Services (Conduct) Amendment Rules, 2019.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Central Civil Services (Conduct) Rules, 1964, in rule 13,—

(a) in sub-rule (3), for clauses (i) and (ii), the following clauses shall be substituted, namely:—

“(i) rupees five thousand in the case of a Government servant holding any Group ‘A’ or Group ‘B’ post; and

(ii) rupees two thousand in the case of a Government servant holding any Group ‘C’ post.”;

(b) for sub-rule (4), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—

“Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-rules (2) and (3), a Government servant, being a member of the Indian delegation or otherwise, may receive and retain gifts from foreign dignitaries in accordance with the provisions of the Foreign Contribution (Acceptance or Retention of Gifts or Presentations) Rules, 2012, as amended from time to time.”.
