## NOTIFICATION

- G.S.R. 58(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and supersession of Department of Company Law Administration (Class I. II and III Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1962, if are as they relate to the post of Junior Technical Assistant except as respects thing done or omitted to be done before a supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Junior Technical Assistant in the Offices of the Regional Directors, Registrars of Companies and Official Liquidator in Department of Company Affairs, namely:—
- i. Short title and commencement:—(1) These rules may be called the Department of Company. Affairs fices of the Regional Directors, Registrars of Companies and Official Liquidator (Junior Technical Assistant) Recment Rules. 2000.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- Number of post, classification and scale of pay:—The number of post its classification and the Scale of attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
  - 3. Method of recruitment Age, timit and other qualification:—The aethod of recruitment to the said postimit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedul.
    - Disqualification : No person :—
    - (a) Who has entered into or contracted as marriage with a person having spouse living, or
    - (b) Who having a spouse fiving, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.
- Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the person applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing exemperson from the operation of this rule.
- Powers to relax: Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient a
  it may by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect

Saving: Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other conference to be provided for the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicement and other specializates persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
