- (a) whether any steps have been taken by Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) to punish violation of code of ethics of sharing of fees with non-members and soliciting of professional work in international brand name by Multi National Accounting Firms (MNAFs) in view of Supreme Court's judgement at Writ Petition No. 991 of 2013, if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) whether any action is taken by ICAI against 171 Multi-National Accounting Firms for violation of code of ethics as per above Supreme Court's judgement; if so, the details thereof?
